


The Calumet City Historical Society presents:



Duneland Dynamics: Scenes and Stories of the Dunes

By Prof. Kenneth Schoon

This presentation integrates dozens of colorful scenes of today's Indiana Dune and describes their ecological importance and stories from yesteryear. Topics include fur trading and a small French "fort," our Revolutionary War skirmish, hermits, developers, and scams, railroads, the birth of American ecology, and efforts to save the dunes amid efforts to industrialize, the new Midwest birding festival, and the "3-Dune Challenge." Dr. Kenneth J. Schoon is a professor emeritus of science education at Indiana University Northwest. His research interests center around local studies and misconceptions in science.
